Electronically file your return instead!

- ◆ You may receive your refund in two weeks.
- ◆ You may choose to have your refund directly deposited into your bank account.
- ◆ You will save tax dollars.
- ◆ You will eliminate errors that further delay your refund.

Iowa e-file options include...

- ◆ Filing your state and federal return together through a tax preparer.
- ◆ Filing your state and federal returns online through an approved software company.
- ◆ Filing your state return free through WebFile at www.state.ia.us/tax
- ◆ Filing your state return through TeleFile.

SPECIAL FEDERAL REBATE CHECK

Do **not** include the amount of the special advanced refund (rebate) check you received from the federal government on line 27 of the Iowa 1040.

RETURNS/PAYMENTS MUST BE MAILED TO

Are you receiving a refund? Mail your return to Iowa Income Tax - Refund Processing, Hoover State Office Building, Des Moines IA 50319-0120.

Are you paying additional tax? Mail your return and payment to Iowa Income Tax - Document Processing, PO Box 9187, Des Moines IA 50306-9187.

EXTENSION REQUESTS

Our agency does not have an extension form to obtain additional time to file. If at least 90% of your total tax liability is paid by April 30, you will automatically have until October 31, 2002, to file your return. You will not be charged a penalty. However, you will pay interest on any tax still due after April 30.

If you need to make a tax payment to meet the 90% requirement, you may now do so online at www.state.ia.us/tax. Otherwise, please use the IA1040V payment voucher form included in this booklet.

PAY IOWA INCOME TAX ONLINE!

You may now pay your Iowa income tax online at www.state.ia.us/tax. This process allows you to choose the date you want the payment taken from your bank account. You will receive a confirmation e-mail and an additional e-mail notifying you when the payment is to be taken.

If you pay by mail, please use the IA 1040-V Payment Voucher. Two vouchers are enclosed in this booklet. Iowa does not have a payment plan option. File your return by April 30, 2002. Pay as much tax with the voucher as you can, and you will be billed for the balance due plus applicable interest and penalty.

INJURED SPOUSE

“Injured spouse” is not recognized by the State of Iowa when filing “married filing a joint return,” filing status 2. If your spouse’s refund will be used to pay a Federal, state, county or city debt, you must use the IA 1040 Long Form, filing status 4, married filing separate returns. This will ensure that your refund will not be applied to your spouse’s debt.
